Newton Medical Center (NMC) offers walk-in health care with a broad range of services in two locations – Newton and Park City. If your primary care physician isn't available, and it's not serious enough for an ER, walk-in care can be an affordable alternative.

Our Services

NMC walk-in care clinics offer same-day treatment for non-emergency illnesses and injuries. Common needs include:

- Allergies
- Athlete's foot
- Bug bites and stings
- Cold sores
- Coughs
- Cuts, bruises & minor burns
- Department of Transportation (DOT) physicals (*call ahead to confirm availability*)
- Ear aches & eye infections
- Fever
- Flu & cold symptoms

- Minor injury evaluation & treatment
- Mononucleosis (mono)
- Nausea
- Respiratory infections
- Ringworm
- Sports physicals

- Childbirth or pregnancy-related issues
- Head trauma
- Loss of consciousness
- Major trauma or accident
- Stroke or stroke-like symptoms
